Juno Church Anniversary

Last Sunday marked the 6th anniversary of the Juno Beach Methodist Church. Following the recommendation of the Commission on Missions, the Church marks this sixth year by introducing a new Parish Plan for its ministry. With still less than 300 members, the Church has begun a mission into the Jupiter-Tequesta area as the second point of this expanding parish. Over the past years, it has sought to minister there and now the establishment of this new Sunday School and preaching point will enable Methodism to touch the many unchurched and the many Methodists who live in Jupiter-Tequesta.

The Parish Plan has been used recently throughout the country. It is an attempt to economize and to unify ministry and members in the missionary enterprise. This parish, which has two Sunday Schools and two preaching points, is served by one minister, one governing body, one office staff, and one budget. This feature of Methodism is as old as the circuit riders who served many points in one parish in the frontier days.

The Juno Beach Methodist Church was begun in 1959 in the "old" Seminole Restaurant in Juno Beach. The Reverend Roy Samply was the organizational pastor and the church began with 35 charter members on May 10 of that year. Rev. Clark Reed came as the first conference appointed minister in June of 1959 and completes his sixth year the end of this month.
